Niwot Road Speeding Measures: Leslie responded and took notes of concern with speeding issues on Niwot Road. She reported that the two locations west of Walker Road that had speed test areas measured recently reported that 85% of average speeds were 45-47 mph. Discussed possible cross walks, lighted signs, speed bumps and where they might be located along Niwot Road. Leslie and Jim reported that there are specific funds designated for Niwot Road. Audrey spoke to her concerns with pedestrians and students who need to cross Niwot Road.

Niwot Sculpture Park Project: Kathy reported that applications for funds are currently being completed.

NCA representative to Niwot LID: Ann reported that she has submitted her resignation for the balance of her term on Niwot LID and proposed that Laura Skaggs be approved to fill that position. Tony and Ann reported on the January LID meeting.

Annual NCA Meeting: We discussed the agenda for the meeting and nominations for offices. Possible topics are traffic control, new park, Nostalgia Day 2011 and other topics.
