Call to Order: 7:05 PM by Heidi Storz.

Guest Speaker: Neal Anderson came to the meeting to review his “Nostalgia Day Lessons Learned and Recommended Actions” that he has established from his years of leadership in preparations, organization and on the event day. There was discussion on the positives and negatives regarding charging for the evening event to help cover costs. Kathy is the NCA representative to the working group, communicating with downtown HOA’s and she will emphasize in the meeting about the Niwot pedestrian safety issue for a crosswalk at Longview Drive / Niwot Road. Laura is on the work group for historic and LID issues and Will is a member to represent the downtown area resident.

Report / Discussion Regarding Road Repair LID: Dick and Pat are working with the County for a community meeting with Boulder County Transportation (George Gerstle and Mike Thomas) presenting options and answering questions regarding establishing an LID. The public meeting will be at the Grange on Monday 27 June, 7:00 PM. The meeting will introduce the proposed LID area with input from homeowners. It was requested that the County also be prepared to present options on a PID for road repairs going forward.

Niwot Pedestrian Friendly Actions: The second speed sign display is scheduled for August 12th – August 28th.

Membership: Terry reported that the number of memberships is at target with many new members joining at Clean Up Day. Efforts should be on-going for memberships.

Mural Painting: Terry will work with Brienne Thiele for the final proposed drawings and then get them to the County for approval. The final cost estimate, including a surface or top protective paint cover, is to be reviewed.
