

**Niwot Community Association (NCA) Meeting  
Wednesday 11 July 2012, MVFPD Station #4, Niwot, Colorado**

**Attendees:** Heidi Storz, Kathy Koehler, Dick Piland, Dave Limbach, Terry Larson, Laura Skaggs, Pat Murphy, Linda Klueber, Steve Pisceke

**Call to Order:** 7:05 PM by Heidi Storz.

**Minutes:** Approved for the June 06, 2012. Minutes will be posted on the NCA web site.

**Treasurers Report:** Terry reported that a little over \$1,000 in sponsorship money for Niwot Nostalgia Day has been deposited along with \$433 collected at the Tip Jar at *Rock N Rails* on June 21 for the mural project.

**Niwot Cleanup Day:** Terry reported that membership collection was almost double from 2011 and that she has not yet received the bill for dumpsters. Heidi said it will be for five dumpsters which are more than previous Cleanup Day.

**MVFPD Station:** Steve reported that the facility update will begin soon so this will be our last meeting in the Station until January 2013. The staff will be relocated during construction, but response time should not be impacted.

**PID Update:** Dick reported he will present 280 resident signatures to Boulder County Transportation Department tomorrow, November ballot wording is still to be completed, it will be upholding the Memorandum of Understanding and he will be taking forward the five nominees for the Board to oversee the PID taxes that would be collected along with the Transportation Department. The Boulder County Commissioners stated that they would like to look at possibly a countywide LID, but the NCA has stated that they think there is a better way to resolve road conditions over long term with a PID which could be countywide, not just Niwot. Dick made a motion: Should the County come to the NC, or we go to them, we are willing to table the Niwot proposed PID would the Boulder County Commissioners consider a countywide PID. The motion was seconded by Terry. Discussion followed. All NCA Board in attendance approved the motion, none opposed. On August 16, Boulder County Transportation will present viable solutions to the road maintenance issue to the Commissioners. Dick will work to set up open forum public meetings in Niwot on September 12 and on October 24. These two meetings will abide by the mandate of five public meetings to inform voters on the proposed Niwot Service Area PID before the November ballot.

**2012 Niwot Nostalgia Day:** Kathy stressed that sponsors are critical for the event and because the deadline for submission of the form has passed she will redo the form and distribute it to Board members tomorrow. Terry reported that the Rotary is moving forward with the Classic Car Show and they will probably have food and drink vendors confirmed soon. A third meeting with Boulder County Events staff regarding all logistics will be necessary for final approval to proceed.
