

**Niwot Community Association (NCA) Meeting**  
**Wednesday 03 October 2012, 7205 Gold Nugget Drive, Niwot, Colorado**

**Call to Order:** 7:10 PM by Heidi Storz.

**Guest Speaker:** Debbie Lammers, member of the St. Vrain Valley School District (SVVSD) Board of Education presented information about the upcoming election regarding ballot issue for funding: charter schools, class sizes, teachers and recruiting of staff and expanding special programs. The first hour of the meeting was presentation and discussion. Then Debbie requested the NCA become a signature of support for advertisements on the November ballot issue for the SVVSD. A motion was made to add the NCA name to the advertising, it was seconded. Voting was three to put the NCA in the advertisement, two abstained, one vote not to be in the advertisement. The question was posed as to whether public endorsements on voting issues is within the NCA By Laws. The three votes to publicly support the ballot issue carried.

**Minutes:** Approved for September 05, 2012. Minutes will be posted on the NCA web site.

**Treasurer Report:** Terry presented the current balance and noted that not all bills have been received / paid for Niwot Nostalgia Day.

**PID Update:** Dick reported that the Niwot hybrid PID was not accepted by the Boulder County Commissioners. Our efforts may have made an impact on the vote that the Commissioners made to propose a county-wide PID for the November 2013 general election ballot. Dick reminded the Board members of the meeting on Wednesday 24 October at the Grange with George Gertsle of Boulder County Transportation. The meeting is to inform the community members of the status of the Niwot proposed PID and report actions that the Boulder County Commissioners have taken on the issue of county roads.

**2012 Niwot Nostalgia Day:** There was general discussion regarding the bill from Highway Technologies for drawings and road signs for the event that were required by Boulder County Event Planning office. Heidi is going to follow up with request for an itemized statement so we know the prices of the total bill and we can plan for future events.

**MVFPD update:** Steve reported that the construction progress on expansion of Station #4 is positive and on target for completion at the end of 2012 or early 2013. Currently the MVFPD is going through an analysis process that is quite complex and they anticipate an industry accreditation upon completion. They are working to put two defibrillators in each school within their District and their public education program has increased dramatically this year. The MVFPD has taken in less revenue in the past several years in Boulder County area stations with expansions in Mead, Erie and east of Longmont.
