

## Niwot Community Association (NCA) Annual Meeting

**Attendees:** About 50 guests attended

**Call to Order:** 7:00 PM by Dick Piland.

**Welcome:** Dick welcomed everyone and thanked them for coming and introduced the Agenda.

**Introduction of those running for NCA Board positions:** Dick thanked Heidi Storz, as outgoing President, for her years of service to the Niwot Community Association. Those who are on the annual ballot for NCA Board positions who were in attendance were introduced: Dick Piland, President; David Limbach, Vice President; Heidi Storz, Trails and Open Space; Area 1 Representative candidates Bruce McKay, Cindy Butler, Judy Seaborn; Area 2 Representative Diane Zimmermann; Area 3 Representative, Pat Murphy; Area 5 Representative, Bre Thiele. **Boulder City Municipalization Plan, How it Affects Niwot:** Dick provided an overview.

**Boulder County Public Improvement District (PID), Presentation on Rehabilitation of Subdivision Roads:** Dick introduced George Gerstle, Director of the Transportation Department of Boulder County and Michelle Krezek, Staff Deputy for the Boulder County Board of Commissioners. George presented the updated information on road conditions in unincorporated Boulder County, explained the purpose and benefits of the proposed PID proposed for the November election. He fielded many questions from the audience and addressed each situation raised by residents.

**Calendar of NCA Future Events:** Dick reminded everyone of the upcoming Niwot Clean Up Day on Saturday 04 May that is sponsored by the NCA. He shared that the NCA is going through the process of application to Boulder County Event Planning to sponsor the 4<sup>th</sup> of July parade for the Niwot community. The audience was informed that there would not be a 36<sup>th</sup> Annual Niwot Nostalgia Day parade and event this year, but that the NCA is working with other community groups to purchase the required traffic signs for such events. In late September or early November there will be an activity for Niwot community volunteers in association with Boulder County Parks and Open Space on a project in the Monarch open space.

**Nonprofit Community Groups Need Our Support:** Dick encouraged attendees to visit the tables in the Lobby for organizations in the community. They are here tonight to share what they bring of services and events in the Niwot community and that all volunteer groups need more support in order to put on these events for residents.
