

## Niwot Community Association (NCA) Meeting Minutes

November 2, 2016

1. Call to Order: Dick Piland called meeting to order at 7:04.

- 3. Approval of the minutes of the 10/05/2016 meeting: The minutes were unanimously approved.
- 4. Treasurers Report: Terry Larsen absent. No report received.
- 5. Chairman's Report:
  - a. The 2017 budget was proposed and unanimously approved.
  - b. The Pumpkin Festival was reported to be an impressive success
  - c. The Holiday Parade Schedule for Saturday, November 26th was discussed
  - d. A proposal to purchase NCA shirts for use by board members at official functions was approved. Motion budget was set at \$350.

f. Replacement of 5 Road Closure Signs was discussed. Dick Piland, Lance Goff and Johnny Barrett will look into whether replacement sign holders can be obtained locally before an out of state order is made, due to high shipping costs.

g. Dick Piland lead a discussion about the NCA Grant Program. A donation to the Children's Park for park maintenance was considered. A motion was made and unanimously approved to donate \$1,000 to the Niwot Grange, to help pay for recent building maintenance bills.
