Lists of electors and property owners

These links will take you to places where you can get lists of electors or property owners. The County charges a small fee to obtain a list of electors. What you'll get from them is a list of all registered votes in the County. You'll need to extract from this the ones with addresses in your District. The search for property owners is interactive and will return a list online of current owner of taxable property in a designated subdivision. You'll need the legal description of the subdivisions in your District in order to use this feature.
