Red Flag Actions

What should I do when a red flag warning has been issued in my area?



DO

Sign up to receive local emergency alerts.



Fill up your gas tank. Avoid parking inside your garage – instead back into your driveway to save time during an evacuation.



Ensure you have a bag ready to go. Make sure that it has your essentials included. Include things such as medication, wallet, purse, keys, glasses, cell phone(s), charger(s), Emergency cash, credit card, Pets, carriers, leashes, meds, clothes, shoes, hats for season, hearing aids, flashlights, safety deposit box key(s), hard drives (backed up data)



Clear flammable material from around your property. Make sure your gutters are clear of debris and ensure your patio furniture is not exposed.



DON'T

Avoid using equipment that may cause sparks or creates an open flame, such as lawn mowers, chainsaws, or propane torches.



Do not have campfires and follow all posted restrictions. Avoid outdoor burning, fire pits, fireworks, and barbecues.



Do not drive or park on grass. Ensure that trailer chains do not drag on the ground when towing, and NEVER throw a cigarette out the window.
