- Construction Debris (e.g. dry wall)
- Oil Based Paints
- Solvents
- Hazardous and/or Hard to Recycle Items
- Animal Waste
- Automobile Tires
- Batteries
- CFL/Fluorescent Tubes
- Waste from businesses – e.g. contractor trash

Fees

NCA Members:

- Two Free Trash Loads
 - 1 Load = Standard sized pickup at bed level
 - Additional Trash Runs at \$25 per load
- Recycling at no charge
 - Except as shown

Non-Members:

- \$40 per Trash Load
